Uncoupling with a skewer

- 1. Spot the car(s)
- 2. Introduce some slack
- Insert the point of the skewer between the two knuckles
- 4. While gently pushing down, rotate the skewer clock-wise (limit how far the point goes in, to prevent binding)
- 5. After the lips of the knuckles "roll" clear of each other, push horizontally against one of the coupler heads to separate the cars













Uncoupling with a skewer

If you miss getting the point of the skewer inbetween the knuckles, and get it in either of the 2 spots shown by the arrows in the photo, not to worry.

Just rotate the skewer counter-clockwise instead.

After the lips of the knuckles "roll" clear of each other, push horizontally against one of the coupler heads to separate the cars
